As always, the Friends of the Library and other special provider partners will have information and provide help with this fun event.

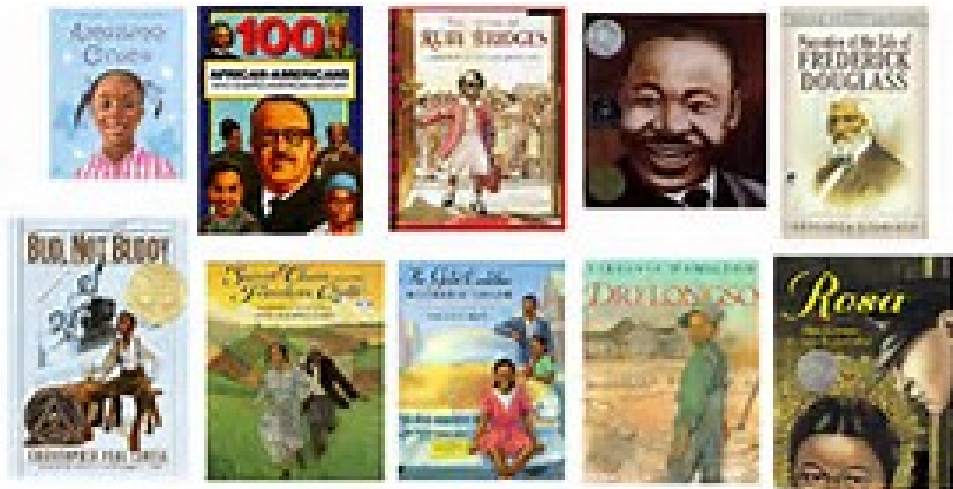
