These cold winter days are a great time to visit Caruthersville Public Library and indulge in a little reading or viewing pleasure.

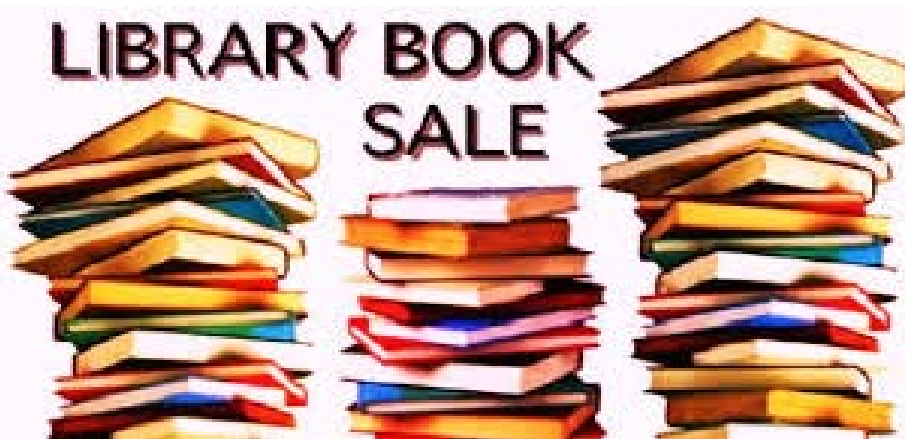
