This will also allow those citizens who use our library but do not own personal or real estate property to contribute to our library with their spending at local businesses.

Kamaria Pearson with the MO Department of Conservation will hold the final fishing class on July 11th, with the presentation of the \$25.00 Bass Pro Shop gift cards for the completion of the course. The week of July 25th will be the wrap up of our program, with certificates and treats (along with yet another goodie bag).

Speaking of fishing, we still have crappie and catfish rods available for checkout, along with a number of pre-filled tackle boxes for your enjoyment. These may be checked out for two weeks.
