Laptop Computers for Programming Now Available

Five new laptops are now available for special programs for our patrons. This technology was made available to our library in order to improve library service through the use of federal Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) funds. These grants are based on LSTA priorities and Missouri State Library goals as approved in the LSTA five-year and state fiscal year project plans.

Beginning June 9 at 10 a.m. is "Prime Time" for those 50 years of age and over. Computer training and advice will be provided to those who are interested in becoming competent on the computer, using specific software or websites. Subjects in June will be e-Mail, cyber safety and security, Facebook and Pinterest.

Also beginning June 9 at 4 p.m. is "Hour of Coding" for children in grades 5-8. Children will learn the basics of computer coding in a non-threatening way to become used to this system to begin programming.
