Early Literacy Grant assists learning



Caruthersville Public Library has recently been performing outreach to several daycares and preschool classrooms to show them the new board books and iPads purchased with an Early Literacy Grant, supported by the Institute of Museum and Library Services under the provisions of the Library Services and Technology Act as administered by the Missouri State Library, a division of the office of Secretary of State Jay Ashcroft.

The students have all been very interested and engaged in the stories and eager to try out the various learning games and hear stories in the TumbleBook Library, which is also provided to MO Public Libraries free of charge from the MO State Library.

We would like to thank Raising Arrows day care, as well as DAEOC Early Headstart (three classrooms) for allowing us to come in to their centers and interact with the children there. It has not only been a fun experience for the kids, but the library has learned how efficient these centers are at teaching the children learning skills like the alphabet, the numbers, left and right sides, writing their names, and many other tasks we never even thought about happening in the preschool years.


