#### Did you know?

- -Libraries are the most trusted institution in America Compared to the findings of a Gallup poll on "confidence in public institutions", a 2012 Pew survey found that libraries are more trusted than any other institution, including the military, churches, and the police.
- **-Libraries are book experts** The #1 reason people go to libraries is for books. Libraries are the most trusted source for book referrals.
- **-Librarian book recommendations are effective**The CodexGroup data shows that recommendations from libraries are much more likely to result in a reader rating a book highly than those of other sources such as Kindle Daily Deals.
- **-Library readers buy more expensive books**Statistics suggest library readers are more likely to buy hardbacks than other buyers.
- **-Merchandising works in libraries** Libraries in locations as diverse as Adams County, CO and Tulsa, OK have seen dramatic improve in
