Children's Author to Appear May 3rd

Children's author Carolyn Mueller will be at Caruthersville Public Library on May 3rd at 6 p.m. This event is open to all and free of charge.

Carolyn is a resident of St. Louis and works at the St. Louis Zoo. From this experience, she believes that every animal has its own special story. From this belief, Bubbles the Dwarf Zebu, her first children's book, was born. Bubbles the Dwarf Zebu was published by Reedy Press in 2012.

Carolyn's other works include Lily: A True Story of Courage and the Joplin Tornado, inspired by Tara Prosser and her Weimaraner, Lily, and Happy Birthday, St. Louis!, a history of St. Louis for kids. Dizzy Dean and the Gashouse Gang, which recounts the harrowing adventures of the 1934 St. Louis Cardinals, and St. Louis Boo, true St. Louis ghost stories for kids were released in the Fall of 2015. Carolyn's latest work, Missouri Almanac 2018-19 is a collaboration with a team of Missouri authors. The Almanac is weird, wild, and filled with fun, delivering the ultimate tour of the Show-Me-State. Carolyn continues to balance her passions for zookeeping and writing. She enjoys working with lions, tigers, bears and more in her current position as a Carnivore Keeper and sharing her stories in the city of St. Louis.
