Early Literacy Grant recently awarded to Caruthersville Public Library

Caruthersville Public Library was recently notified that an early literacy grant was awarded to be used to purchase iPads and board books to involve day care centers and early learning sites in digital literacy.

Just this year alone, the library has received laptop computers and upgraded the circulation desk technology, as well as receiving over \$17,300 to digitize **The Democrat-Argus** newspaper from 1891-1966, and \$3000 in Collection Development funding, which was used to purchase Do-It-Yourself books for adults and Makerspace/Crafting books for children. A summer reading grant was also awarded that assisted in purchasing supplies for our very successful "Build a Better We
