Overdrive Advantage Now Available

Caruthersville Public Library is now an Overdrive Advantage library. This will enable patrons who enjoy checking out audiobooks to avoid the frustration they may have felt in the past when they were placed on a long waiting list for the book or eAudio of their choice. Now, with Overdrive Advantage, our patrons can place their hold and on the 10th of every month, they will move to number one on the waiting list and receive the materials on which they have placed holds.

Another feature is the "Recommend to Library" button. Here, our patrons can make recommendations of materials, which may not be available at this time, that they would like to see us purchase. These purchases will be made on the first day of every month.

Users of the Overdrive and MOLib2Go service will find that both of these improvements will make their utilization of the digital platforms a much more pleasant experience without the wait or the disappointment of finding a book or audio that they would like to check out is not available.
